| Scoring | More than 3 years of experience: +2 points for each additional year, up to maximum of 20 points. | Exactly 3 years of experience. | Collaboration with more than 2 specialized institutions: +2 points for each additional collaboration, up to maximum of 20 points. | Collaboration with 2 specialized institutions (e.g., rapid response, special forces, first aid). | Full compliance with technical specifications (dimensions, materials, functionalities) and submission of relevant compliance certificates. | Partial compliance with technical specifications and/or missing relevant compliance certificates. | Non-compliance with ToR specifications. | The evaluation under the "price" criterion will be based on the following formula: $P = P_{min} / P_{of} \times 30$ pts, where: P _{min} – the lowest proposed price P _{of} – the price presented in the examined offer P – the number of points awarded to the examined offer based on the price criterion, rounded to the nearest whole number. |
